Red Cell Antibody Investigation BC_REF-01

TEST DESCRIPTION

Red cell antibody identification is performed when atypical antibodies are detected through the antibody screen test or when a Direct Antiglobulin Test (DAT) is positive. The investigation will determine if the identified antibody is clinically significant.

SPECIMEN AND REQUISITION REQUIREMENTS

Specimen(s)

- Minimum of three (3) 6-7ml (lavender) tubes, unless pediatric patient, mixed thoroughly by gentle agitation.
- Label specimen with the required minimum information: patient's last name, first name, PHN or unique identifier and date of collection.

Complete Requisition (must include)

- · Patient's last name, first name, date of birth and PHN or unique identifier
- · Facility name, complete address, phone and fax number
- · Phlebotomist ID information
- Date of collection

PRE-SHIPPING STORAGE

Recommended Refrigeration 1-10°C.

SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

Submit samples as soon as possible after collection.

Shipping

- Ship in a container that will maintain temperature at ≥1°C.
- Select shipping method for container to arrive at testing site within 48 hours.

Note: Protect from freezing.
