Implementation Update; Extension of Platelet Components Shelf Life From 5 to 7 Days

Dear Customer:

Further to Customer Letter #2017-02 and Customer Letter #2017-13, Health Canada has approved the extension of platelet components shelf life from 5 to 7 days. The implementation date is set for Monday August 14th, 2017.


During the first few days as we transition from 5 to 7 day platelets, there will be a slight delay in receiving fresh inventory. This is because platelets collected on Monday will not be available for issue until 18 hours later than our current 5 day expiry process, due to the change in testing algorithm.

We ask for your understanding and cooperation with the following:

- Delivery of platelet components with any expiry date.
- Doses of platelets may be imported from Héma-Québec to help offset the delay. Hospitals are reminded to make sure they have Héma-Québec component codes set up in their laboratory information system.
